### **CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS:**

Gently wipe the cabinet with a soft cloth

To clean the cabinet, dampen the cloth with a neutral detergent and water, wipe the cabinet and follow with a dry cloth.

Do not clean with benzene thinner, alkaline detergent, alcoholic system detergent, glass cleaner, wax, polish cleaner, soap powder, or insecticide.

#### Hardware

The required hardware parts are

The wood dowels are labeled as (H1) x 8.

The conformat screws are labeled as (H2) x 8.

The shelf pins are labeled as (H3) x 8.

The nails are labeled as (H4) x 24.

The nail holders are labeled as (H5) x 1.

The screw cover is labeled as (H6) x 1.

### The anti-tip hardware parts are

The L Bracket is labeled as (H7) x 1.

The two washers are labeled as (H8) x 2.

The wall anchor is labeled as (H9) x 1.

The 2"3/8 screw TC is labeled as (H10) x 1.

The 3/8" flat-head screw is labeled as (H11) x 1.

The parts for assembly are identified alphanumerically for ease.

The side panel (Lh) is labeled as A.

The side panel (Rh) is labeled as B.
The two top-bottom panels are labeled as C.
The back panel is labeled as D.
The two shelves are labeled as E.

### **HELPFUL HINTS**

We recommend you protect your work surface during assembly to prevent scratching or damage to table tops, wood floors, etc.

Unfinished edges are shaded in gray. It is important to understand how finished edges go together. Take a moment to lay out all the wood pieces and note the finished and unfinished (raw wood) edges. Arrange pieces so all finished edges are facing the same way. While assembling, take care to note in each diagram which way finished edges are facing. In general, all finished edges will face forward and all finished sides (large area of piece) will face up when product is fully assembled and upright.

# HAND TIGHTEN SCREWS

We recommend you hand-tighten screws. Use care not to overtighten if using power tools.

## STEP 1:

Carefully tap wood dowels (H1) into place in two C.

### STEP 2:

Attach top and bottom panels (C) onto side panels (A) and (B).

Ensure wood dowels are aligned correctly with the holes of matching parts before attaching. Secure top and bottom panels (C) onto side panels (A) and (B) using screwdriver to turn fitting conformat screw to fix.

### STEP 3:

Position back panel (D) onto the created frame.

## STEP 4:

Before attaching the back panel (D), checking the correct allocation.

### STEP 5:

Attach back panel (D) onto back side of the unit using all 24x nail (H4) evenly distributed with the help of the nail guide (H5) as shown.

### STEP 6:

With help of an assistant, carefully stand up the unit.

## STEP 7:

Attach screw cover (H6) over screw heads.

### STEP 8:

Insert shelf pin (H3) as shown.

Position the shelves (E) on the shelf pin (H3) as shown.

Press firmly until you don't see the shelf pins (H3) anymore.

## STEP 9:

All units must be secured to the wall with anti-tip hardware.

Fix the L Bracket (H7) under the top of the unit using washer (H8) and 3/8" screw (H11). Do not fully tighten.

Alight the unit against the wall and mark the location of the L Bracket (H7) against the wall.

#### STFP 10.

Fix the wall anchor using the drill.

For Wood: If fixing to wood make sure that it isn't chipboard as screws can easily pull away from the core structure.

Drill 1/8 inch diameter pilot hole, at the height you marked with pencil.

For Masonry or brick: Drill 5/16 inch diameter pilot hole and 3/4 inch deep into the wall at the height you marked with pencil.

Drive plastic plug into the hole, using a hammer if needed.

# For Cavity wall:

Drill 5/16 inch diameter pilot hole at the height you marked with pencil.

Drive plastic plug into the hole, using a hammer if needed.

### **STEP 11:**

Fix the L Bracket (H7) to the wall using washer (H8) and 2 3/8" screw TC (H10). Tighten screw (H11) into unit and screw (H10) into wall.

Your assembly is complete. Your shelf bookcase is now ready for use. The red TARGET logo appears and fades from the screen.
