## WINDOW CLINGS





## **Supplies**

- 3 tbsp Elmer's White School Glue
- 8 drops food coloring
- 3-4 drops dish soap
- Bowl
- Schoolbook sheet protectors
- ✓ Paint brush · Measuring spoons

## Instructions

- **1.** In a bowl, pour 3 tbsp of Elmer's White Glue and 8 drops of food coloring.
- 2. Stir until food coloring and glue are evenly mixed, then add 3-4 drops of dish soap to the mixture.
- 3. To create a heart, dip a paint brush into the mixture, then use it to paint a heart on a sheet protector. Or make this your own by choosing any design you'd like! You can also add bits of glitter or more food coloring to spice things up.
- **4.** Let the design dry for 60 minutes, then peel your sheet protector from your design. Stick your design to your window and admire!
