

Ready. Set. Create



Supplies

4 fl oz Elmer's White School Glue
5 fl oz Elmer's Clear School Glue

A design pattern of your choice (cut to the size of the glass)

Various colors of AP
approved acrylic paint

- Paintbrushes
- A skewer for mixing
- Small bowls for mixing colors

Activity Time 30 Minutes Wait Time Overnight

Ages: 8+, Adult Supervision Required

Instructions

- 1. Have an adult remove the glass from the picture frame and place over a design pattern of your choice.
- **2.** Add about 1 tsp of black acrylic paint into the bottle of Elmer's White School Glue and use a skewer to mix in the glue bottle. Place cap back on the bottle.
- **3.** Use the glue bottle to add black "leading" lines on your glass to create your design. Allow to dry overnight.
- **4.** Mix your colors one at a time. Add a few of drops of 1 acrylic paint color into a small bowl. Then, mix in about 3 tbsp of Elmer's Clear School Glue to the paint.
- 5. Repeat step 5 to create additional colors.
- 6. Use paintbrush to heavily add the paint inside the leading lines. Be sure to go all the way to the leading. Allow project to dry for several hours.
- 7. Display on your window seal to enjoy your designs!
